ACCESS Summer English Language Camps

are designed for children and teens who want to have fun while they are learning English! Participants will make friends from around the world, visit exciting tourist sites, and get to know Canada all at the same time.

Students will attend weekday morning English classes, and take part in exciting daily afternoon trips and activities. The weekends include day trips to various destinations. Led by our teachers, the trips are a fun way for students to see the Toronto area with their classmates, meet students from other countries around the world, and practice speaking English all at the same time!

Students have the option of choosing from two camps: Our TORONTO camp gives students the excitement of living and studying in a big city. Our HAMILTON camp gives students the experience of living in a smaller city located in between Toronto and Niagara Falls. Students visit Toronto on many of our teacher-guided day trips. Whichever camp they choose, students are guaranteed to go home with memories to last a lifetime!

English Classes

ACCESS classes focus on teaching fundamental skills (grammar, writing, reading, speaking and listening) in an integrated way. Teachers use the communicative approach, and careful attention is paid to ensuring lessons are both interactive and fun. Students will practice speaking in pairs and small groups. All classes pay special focus to developing oral skills. Presentation and group activities are an integral part of the program. Students receive feedback and evaluations on all projects.

Trips & Activities

Trips and activities are an essential part of our camps. We believe that students learn through doing, and participating in school activities is a great way to practice newly learned English language skills! Teachers, Activity Staff and Canadian Teen Buddies (Hamilton only) join the students to supervise, motivate, and encourage interaction in English.

Students

Our students come from a number of different countries around the world including: Russia, Korea, Spain, Japan, Venezuela, Brazil, Saudi Arabia, Switzerland, and more. All students are expected to speak in English during class time and while on all trips and activities.

Teachers

All teachers are university graduates, TESL certified, and have extensive experience teaching students from diverse cultural backgrounds. ACCESS camp teachers are chosen based on their experience, skill and motivation.



TORONTO *ages 7 - 17 years* population: 3 million

Location

Located at Yonge & Bloor streets, in the centre of downtown, close to the University of Toronto, and a 1-minute walk from the Yonge/Bloor subway station. ACCESS is surrounded by shops & take out restaurants offering international food.

Trips & Activities

Daily teacher-guided afternoon activities plus one day trip every Saturday are included in the program. Sundays are spent with friends or Host Families.

Transportation

The Toronto bus and subway system are safe and easy to use. Students & teachers will use local transit to travel to all weekday activities. Students must purchase a TTC pass to get to/from camp as well as for use on weekday trips. Most Saturday trips are by chartered bus.

Homestay & Off-Campus Residence

Individual students live in Homestay with Canadian families. Hosts provide three meals per day and a warm, comfortable home environment. All families have been carefully screened by our Coordinator to ensure comfort and safety. Students under 14 years will be placed in a homestay with an older student who will accompany them to school. Residence accommodation is available (for groups only) at nearby University of Toronto or Toronto Metropolitan University. Ask ACCESS for more details.

Parent & Child Program

Summer Camp participants who opt to join our Parent & Child program will study at the same campus with their parent and have the opportunity to go on trips together!

HAMILTON ages 10 - 17 years population: 500,000

Location

On the campus of Hillfield Strathallan College, a prestigious private school, our Hamilton Camp offers modern facilities. The campus has a gym, sports fields, & picnic areas. Conveniently located half-way between Toronto & Niagara Falls, Hamilton is a 45 minute drive from both cities, making it the perfect place to visit & learn English.

Trips & Activities

Students experience the perfect combination of teacherguided trips & activities both in the Hamilton area, and in Toronto and Niagara. Chartered buses take us on all trips!

Transportation

Depending on distance, students in homestay either walk, take the bus, or receive our "daily drive" service. or more.) Students in residence have a 2-minute walk to the camp.

Homestay & On-Campus Residence

Homestays are recommended for those who are looking for a cultural experience living with a friendly, Canadian family.

Our Hamilton camp has an on-campus residence available for both individuals and groups. Students have their own bedroom (with double bed) in a shared two-bedroom suite. The suite has a small kitchenette, and a full washroom with shower. The residence is equipped with 24-hour security, a laundry room, games room, and even a small movie theatre! Tasty breakfasts, lunches & dinners are included daily.

ACCESS staff live onsite to monitor students and ensure they are well taken care of. Fun evening activities complete the program.

A Broad Range of Camp Activities

Volunteers will assist in one of several areas such as: sports, creative arts, STEM, academic skills, cooking. Ages of Canadian children participating in the camps range from 4 to 15 years.

- MINI EXPLORERS (4 to 5 years) Activities, crafts and gross motor games for young children.
- MIGHTY EXPLORERS IMAGINATION (6 to 7 years) Campers will learn how different people and animals live, create gravity-defying structures, and stay active with games.
- **HEAD START** (4 to 5 years, 6 to 7 years or 8 to 10 years) Literacy and math camp specific to each age group. Fun, academic, skill reviews in a familiar environment with qualified teachers.

THE ART FACTORY (8 to 10 years) Express yourself through art and build new skills. Campers will work on art projects and mix in some daily movement with games.

THE CULINARY ACADEMY (8 TO 13 YEARS) Learn how to make healthy afterschool snacks, measure ingredients for the perfect cupcakes, and plan and cook a well-balanced meal!



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OMNI CAMP (8 TO 10 YEARS) Crafts, games and skill building, mixed with relevant technology.

THE STEM LAB (8 TO 13 YEARS) Campers problem-solve their way through fun challeng-

es and learn about exciting discoveries happening in the world around them!



BASKETBALL (8 TO 15 YEARS) Learn skills, drills & games. A top-level skill development experience.



VOLLEYBALL (8 TO 15 YEARS) Develop volleyball skills & participate in a positive, fun, environment.
