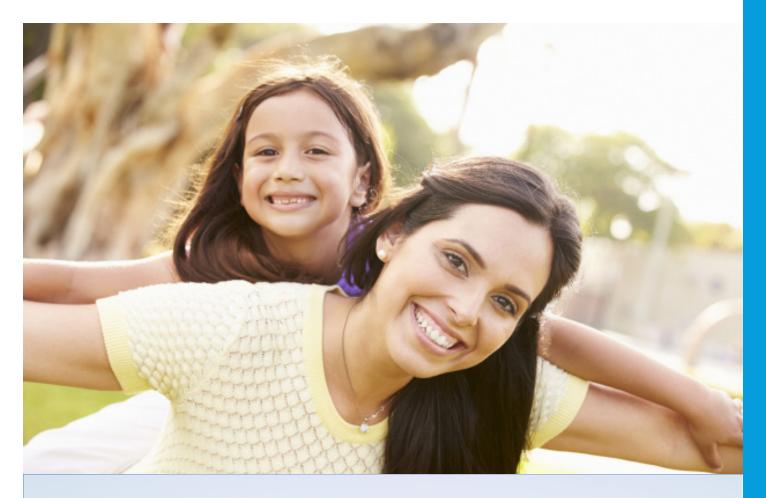

Our Parent & Child Program provides families with a learning experience like no other. Accompany your child or children to Toronto. Together you will learn English in mornings and practice speaking while touring the city in the afternoons. Make friends with other families from around the world. Not only will you improve your English ability quickly, but you will have the extra assurance that that your children are safe and happy. On top of it all, you will return home with memories guaranteed to last a lifetime!

Parents

Parents will study in ACCESS' **Full-Time English program** (20 lessons/week) and have classes in speaking, listening, reading, grammar, writing, vocabulary building, idioms, and slang. A special focus is placed on speaking & listening. All classes follow the communicative method and have students from around the world.

In the afternoons, and on Saturdays, parents may join their children on activities & trips in and around the city of Toronto. (additional charges apply).

Children (ages 7 - 17 years)

Children & teens will have an exciting learning experience integrated with other international students in our **Summer Camp program.**

English classes, with a focus on communicative activities, take place in the mornings. In the afternoons, and on Saturdays, children will participate in exciting trips and activities in and around the city of Toronto. Visit Niagara Falls, CN Tower, Royal Ontario Museum, and Ripley's Aquarium. See the Toronto skyline while on the Voyageur canoeing experience at Centre Island. Practice speaking English with your new friends from around the world!

Acccommodation

Families have the option of registering for the program without accommodation, living together in the same homestay, residential accommodation or a furnished apartment.

Location

Both parents and children will participate in classes at our school's main location in the heart of downtown Toronto. We are located a convenient one minute walk from Yonge/Bloor subway station. Surrounded by restaurants, movie theatres, and office buildings, ACCESS is only a five minute walk from the Royal Ontario Museum and the University of Toronto.
